### Example to introduce words in the dialogue

- Sparrow:** How great is it for how are they doing?

**Robin:** I come from England! A lovely country but the winter is terrible there!  
**Robin:** What about Malta?

**Robin:** How lucky! We have to migrate because of the cold weather, sometimes we come to Malta, sometimes we have going to Africa.

**Robin:** All these hundreds they try to put traps for us to catch us and keep us in a cage! That's very silly because we don't live in cages. We are birds that live in the countryside, definitely not in cages!  
**Sparrow:** That's terrible but unfortunately they keep on killing us!  
**Robin:** Yesterday a man has tried to catch me but I managed to escape.
