

6th Grade Social Studies Course Outline/Requirements

COURSE DESCRIPTION

Sixth grade social studies is a program designed as a world geography, world cultures, and historical development of cultures survey. The program is a two year program. The sixth and seventh graders will be using a textbook entitled Our World Today published by Glencoe. Students will use maps and graphs, research information on major geographic regions of the world, report orally and in writing, take tests, and participate in in-class activities.
