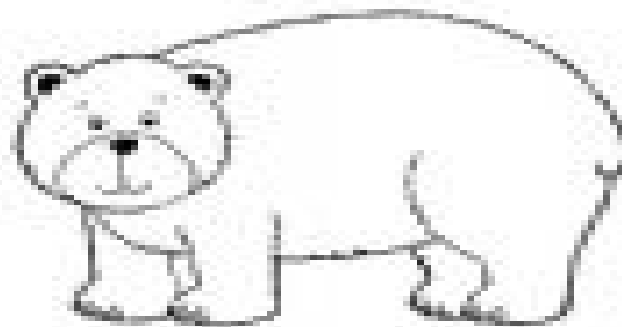


Animals around the world
