- 1) Paleontologist A scientist who studies fossils and ancient life
- Porous Full of tiny holes that water, air, and light can pass through
- 3) Sedimentary Rock Rock made of layers of tightly packed sand and clay
- Fossils Remains of ancient life that have been turned to stone
- 5) Coprolite Fossilized dinosaur dung (scat)
- Fossilization Process by which the remains of ancient living things are turned to rock
- 7) Body Fossil Actual parts of plants and animals that have been turned to stone (i.e. bone, shells, leaves)
- 8) Mineralization to convert into a mineral substance; to fill with a mineral substance
- 9) Sandstone A type of sedimentary rock that is made of sand
- 10) Trace Fossil A fossilized sign that a plant or animal once lived in an area (i.e. footprints, coprolite)
