

Miming sentences with adverbs

Instructions:

1. A student takes one adverb and one verb cards.
2. The student mimes the combination (e.g. catch a ball + lovingly).
3. The others have to guess what was on the two cards and form a grammatical sentence: *You are catching a ball lovingly.*

slowly	Turn on a television
Happily	Drink a cup of tea
Nervously	Climb a tree
Heavily	Clean a window
Angrily	Put on a shirt
Lovingly	Make a bed
Gently	Catch a ball
violently	Type an email
