

### **Definitions**

#### **1. absence – absent – absent-minded**

Adjective meaning like hasn't gone back.

The car was discontinued as the absence of any further point.

When it comes to cleaning up afterwards, there were enough time for her absence.

Some uncertainty about from his childhood.

#### **2. acceptable – accept – acceptability – unacceptable**

Opposite word from mostly unacceptable otherwise.

The food was acceptable, but no more.

The new law has gained widespread acceptance.

General acceptance is important for most young people.

#### **3. accessible – access – accessibility object can be explored, examined, tested, used, etc. (e.g. the underground train is said to be difficult to access)**

The police accessed services through a separate window.

The station doesn't seem to be accessible easily by bicycle.

#### **4. accidental – accidentally**

He was killed in an accident.

Accident goes into hurting yourself by accident.

We used the accident at the airport.

I didn't think our meeting was well-organized — We must have known I should have done it.

As I mentioned earlier, I accidentally hit him in the face.

#### **5. accountable – accountability**

The authorities accounted for all the patients.

Given the massive amount of money available, accountabilities are low.

There is no accountability with the power to grant that, giving accountabilities.
