Segment 2; data from 2008:

- * One piece of data from Spring 08: liked technology presentation; several desired to have Lynn personally come advise or support efforts
- Another piece of data from Spring 08: very much liked the two periods of time per day for team work (up from one team time before)
- Another piece of data from Spring 08: liked the two days/year compared to five days/year of first year

Results of discussing data:

- · Some schools contacted Lynn to have her help them
- · Fall 08 session has two periods of team work time built in
- · Kept to two-day/year format
