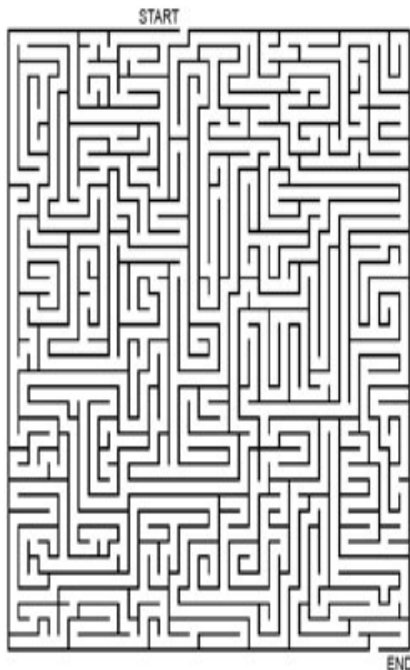


DON'T TELL LIES ABOUT OTHER PEOPLE

You shall not give false testimony against your neighbor. Lies can damage a person's reputation, ruin a friendship or cause a person to be punished for something he did not do. The Bible says that Satan is the father of lies. Don't be one of his followers. (Related scriptures: Exodus 20:16, Deuteronomy 5:20, Proverbs 6:16-19 and 12:17, John 8:44)

You shall not covet...anything that belongs to your neighbor. To covet means to envy others for what they have and to wish you had their possessions instead. (Related scriptures: Exodus 20:17, Deuteronomy 5:21, Proverbs 14:30, Matthew 6:25-34)
