Welcome to 8th grade Social Studies class! We have a very busy year ahead of us. The following will give you an outline of what is expected of you during your time in Social Studies class.

Social Studies Classroom Rules

- 1. Students must be in their seats when the period begins or they will be tardy.
- 2. Students may leave class only in emergency situations or with a pass from a teacher.
- 3. Students are not permitted to leave their desks at any time without permission from the teacher (for example—raise your hand if you need to sharpen your pencil!).
- 4. Students must have permission from the teacher before using the computers.
- 5. Students should remain in their seats until dismissed by the teacher.
- 6. Students may not have candy, gum, drinks, or any other kind of food or beverage in the classroom.
- 7. Name-calling or any form of verbal or physical harassment or disrespect shown to students or staff will result in disciplinary action.
- 8. Papers with no name will result in half credit the first time, then zero credit after that
- 9. If a student is absent it is his/her responsibility to request make-up work from the office and/or teacher. Students will be given the same number of days to make up work as they were absent (two days out equals two days to make up work for full credit).
- 10. Students must bring their materials to class every day.
