Welcome to 8th grade Social Studies class! We have a very busy year ahead of us. The following will give you an outline of what is expected of you during your time in Social Studies class.

Social Studies Classroom Rules

1. Students must be in their seats when the period begins or they will be tardy.
2. Students may leave class only in emergency situations or with a pass from a teacher.
3. Students are not permitted to leave their desks at any time without permission from the teacher (for example—raise your hand if you need to sharpen your pencil!).
4. Students must have permission from the teacher before using the computers.
5. **Students should remain in their seats until dismissed by the teacher.**
6. Students may not have candy, gum, drinks, or any other kind of food or beverage in the classroom.
7. Name-calling or any form of verbal or physical harassment or disrespect shown to students or staff will result in disciplinary action.
8. Papers with no name will result in half credit the first time, then zero credit after that.
9. If a student is absent it is his/her responsibility to request make-up work from the office and/or teacher. Students will be given the same number of days to make up work as they were absent (two days out equals two days to make up work for full credit).
10. Students must bring their materials to class **every day**.
