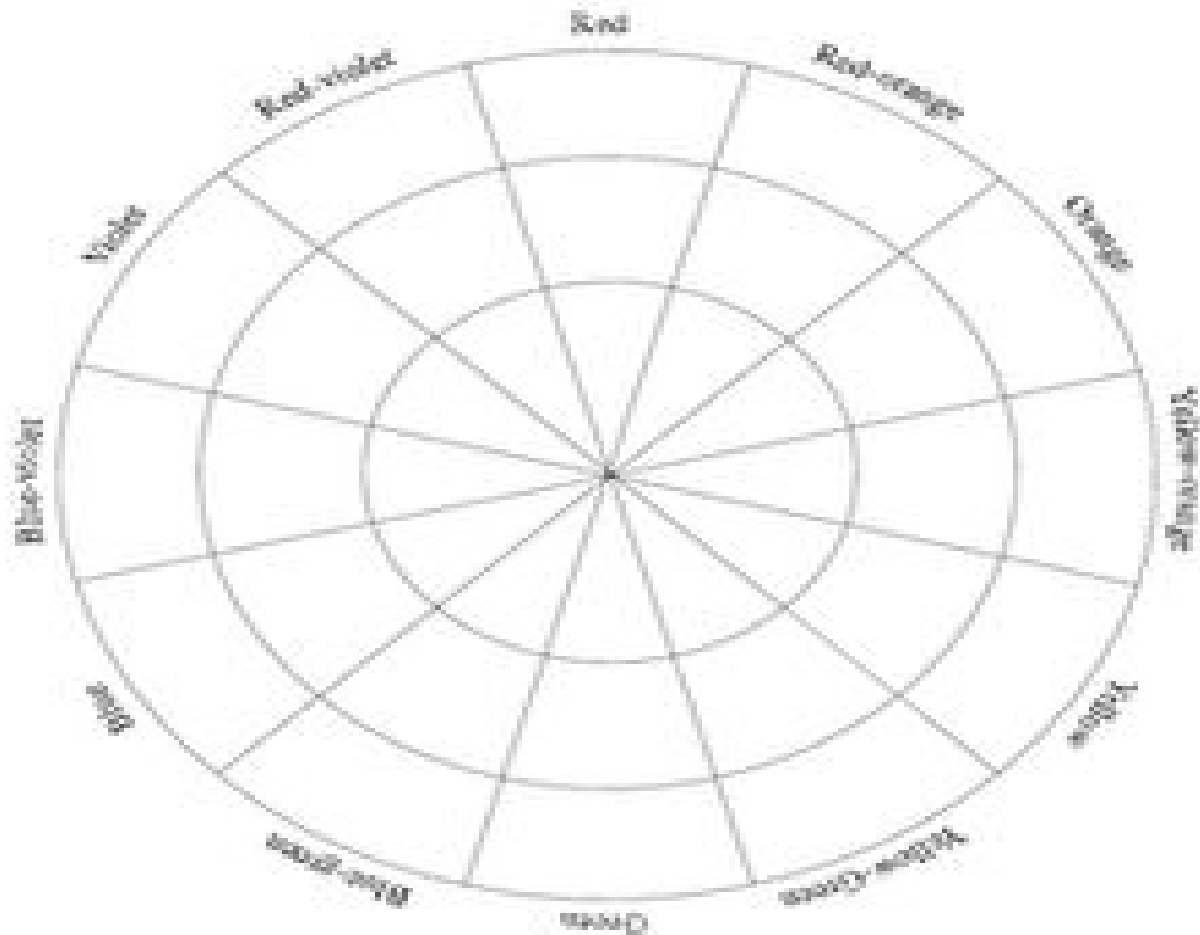


Color Wheel: Tints and Shades

Complete the color wheel below by painting each section neatly.
Paint the middle ring **PURE** colors. Paint the outside ring a **TINT** of each color. Paint the centre ring a **SHADE** of each color. Try to paint each section "flatly" so that there is no variation of color.



Tertiary colors (also known as intermediate colors) are created when you mix a primary color with one of its secondary colors.

For example, when you mix red (a primary) with orange (one of red's secondary colors) you create red-orange. Tertiary colors are always labelled with the primary color listed first.

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
