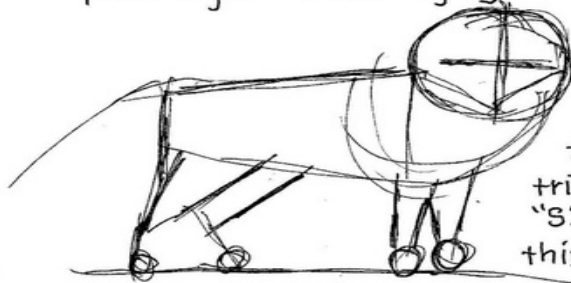


How to Draw a Fox

Make an outline by drawing basic shapes to get the form right. Draw lightly.



the body is a rectangle that is higher by the head. the head starts as a circle on the shoulder of the body.

the back legs are like bent triangles shaped like a backwards "S". the front legs are very thin triangles with circles for feet. use guidelines across and

once you are happy with the basic shape go over it with a dark pencil and erase the extra lines.



down the face to keep things even.

the eyes are below the half way mark, they are small circles with almond shaped eyelids.

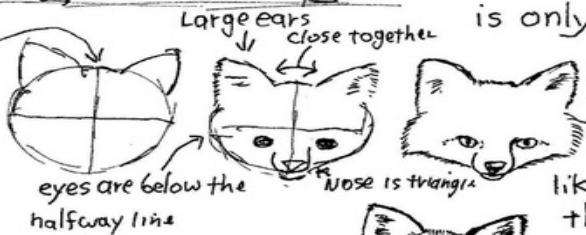
the nose is a triangle pointing down, it is at the end of a narrow muzzle. the mouth

is only a straight line almost touching the nose but not as wide.

the lower jaw is a short line shaped like the letter "U".

the cheek fur goes out and slightly down. the tail is almost as long as the body and almost as wide.

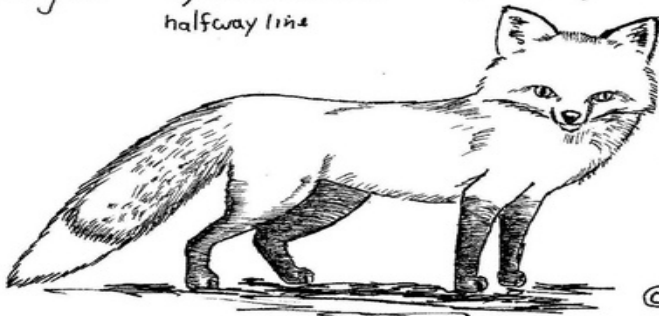
use a guideline to keep things straight.



Large ears close together

eyes are below the halfway line

Nose is triangle
