



## Verb tenses

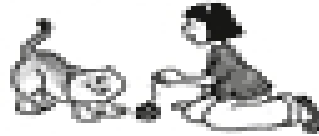
A verb is a word that tells you what something or somebody is doing or being.  
Different verb endings tell us when things happen.

Verbs ending in -ing tell us that something is happening now.

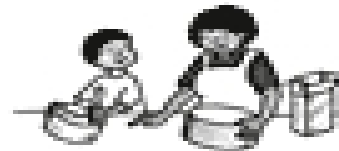
Verbs ending in -ed tell us that something happened before.
