

Change each sentence by using a modal verb expressing certainty or possibility.

1. I'm sure he is at home. → He is at home.
2. There is a slight chance that she is absent. → She may be absent.
3. It's impossible he is not cheating. → He must be cheating.
4. He is very peculiar, maybe he doesn't like chocolate. → He may not like chocolate.
5. He didn't get the job, I guess he arrived late at the interview. → He must have arrived late at the interview.
6. It was his first rehearsal, he was certainly stressed. → He must have been stressed.
7. She doesn't answer his calls, perhaps he is at the cinema. → He may be at the cinema.
8. He looks her leg during the game, she surely hates him. → She must hate him.
9. I'm sure he had an accident. → He must have had an accident.
10. Find it difficult to believe that she is lying to me. → She can't be lying to me.
11. Perhaps he missed the bus. → He may have missed the bus.
12. Logically, they have finished working by now. They should have finished working.
13. I feel he brought flowers again. → He must have brought flowers again.
14. Could I feel he is leaving flowers again. → He may have brought flowers again.
15. Maybe he finds it difficult. → He may find it difficult.
16. At this time, children are sleeping. → They must be sleeping.
17. Perhaps he knows her but I didn't see it. → He may know her but I didn't see it.
