Objective:

Students will use a more complex dichotomous key to identify various animals.

Materials:

- A set of animal pictures (fish, bird, mammal, reptile, amphibian)
- · A dichotomous key for the animals

Dichotomous Key:

- 1. a) Animal has feathers.
- -> Go to step 2
 - b) Animal does not have feathers.
- -> Go to step 3
- 2. a) Animal can fly.

Animal: Bird

b) Animal cannot fly.

Animal: Penguin

- 3. a) Animal has scales.
- -> Go to step 4
 - b) Animal does not have scales.

Animal: Mammal

4. a) Animal lives in water.

Animal: Fish

b) Animal lives on land.

Animal: Reptile
