THE FIRST MOON LANDING

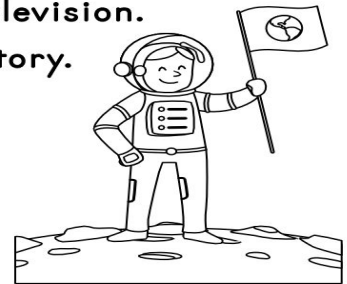
Read the short passage and answer the questions.
