How many students participated altogether?

4. A teacher bought 36 mini flags and divided them equally among 6 students.
How many flags did each student get?

5. A parade used 54 balloons for decorations. After the parade, 21 balloons popped.
How many balloons were left?

6. Emma collected 25 Flag Day stickers and gave 8 stickers to her brother.
How many stickers does Emma have left?

7. A school placed 9 flags in each hallway.
If there are 5 hallways, how many flags were used in total?

8. At a Flag Day picnic, 42 cupcakes were shared equally among 7 tables.
How many cupcakes were placed on each table?
