Addition Problems

1. Emma collected 12 candies while trick-or-treating. Her friend gave her 7 more candies. How many candies does Emma have now?
2. There were 15 pumpkins in the pumpkin patch. The farmer added 9 more pumpkins for decoration. How many pumpkins are there altogether?
3. A haunted house had 18 bats hanging from the ceiling. Workers added 6 more bats. How many bats are hanging now?
4. Noah found 14 pieces of candy corn in his bag and later got 8 more pieces. How many pieces of candy corn does he have in total?
5. At a Halloween party, there were 11 cupcakes on the table. Parents brought 10 more cupcakes. How many cupcakes are there now?

Subtraction Problems

1. Olivia had 20 candies after trick-or-treating. She ate 6 candies before bedtime. How many candies does she have left?
2. A witch made 17 spooky cookies. The children ate 8 cookies. How many cookies remain?
3. There were 19 ghosts decorating the classroom wall. The teacher removed 7 ghosts after the party. How many ghosts are still on the wall?
4. Liam carved 16 pumpkins for a festival. Later, 5 pumpkins were taken to another room. How many pumpkins stayed behind?
5. A basket held 18 chocolate bars. Trick-or-treaters took 9 chocolate bars. How many chocolate bars are left in the basket?
